Hi Geoff,

Just to follow up, for Hall D, there are 5 ARR pre-start items:

- 1) PSS for Halls D must be certified;
- 2) Radiation shielding for Hall D must be installed and verified in-place;
- 3) Complete all open items stemming from the Experiment Readiness Reviews, including verifying that all credited shielding is all in place;
- 4) Complete and sign-off the DRAFT Hall D commissioning plan; and
- 5) Evaluate and update the sweep procedures for all configurations (Hall D, Maintenance and Operation Modes) and establish responsibility for the lock for the Hall D "dark room" and its configuration during searches

Items 1, 2, and 5 completion are the responsibility of Accelerator and Engineering. Key folks are already aware of their responsibilities. Items 3 and 4 have been identified to Patrizia and Rolf.

Exactly how completion of pre-starts will be verified is under discussion right now but will be sorted out in the next day or two. Once the verification has taken place, Mont will send a letter to Joe Arango requesting authorization to commission Hall D with photons. (Beam up to the Hall D Tagger doesn't need any further authorization; nor does accelerator operation or operation to Hall A.)

Hall B has three ARR pre-start items

- 1) ODH system for Hall B must be certified;
- 2) PSS for Halls B must be certified; and
- 3) Complete and sign-off the DRAFT Hall B commissioning plan.

Item 1 is the responsibility of Engineering. Patrizia and Rolf are already aware of their responsibilities for items 2 and 3. Whatever Mary, Mont, and Arne decide for the verification process, the same will likely be applied to Hall B - except that no letter exchange between Mont and Joe Arango is anticipated.
